## Kentish Town C of E After School Clubs

Welcome back everyone; we hope you had a lovely summer.

All after school clubs other than Breakfast club and Activity club will be starting on Monday 10/9/18. If you haven't filled in the registration forms yet, please do ASAP as some clubs are limited to 15 children per session. You can pick up a form from the office or Breakfast Club room, tick the clubs your child would like to attend and return the form to Pam or Sarah in the office. Please do not include any payment as we are in the process of sorting out an on-line payment system and the office will be contacting you shortly with the details.
