

Academic Achievement at Kentish Town C of E Primary School 2018

The school's most recent KS2 (end of primary school) results - provisional

The 2018 KS2 assessments are the third which assess the new, more challenging national curriculum which was introduced in 2014. Results are no longer reported as levels, and each pupil now receives their test results in Reading, Maths and Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling as a scaled score. There is no writing test and teachers assess the standard of writing.

Average progress scores

The overall progress of all pupils in reading, writing and in mathematics is **above** the national figure for all pupils.

Scaled scores

A pupil's scaled score is based on their raw score. The raw score is the total number of marks a pupil scores in a test, based on the number of questions they answered correctly.

- 80 is the lowest scaled score that can be awarded
- 120 is the highest scaled score

A pupil awarded a scaled score of 100 or more has met the expected standard in the test.

A pupil awarded a scaled score of 99 or less has not met the expected standard in the test.

A pupil awarded a scaled score of 110 or more has met a higher standard in the test.
