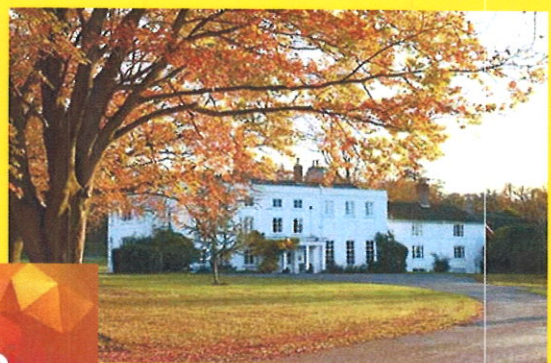

1. What, when and why?

SATs = Statutory Assessment Tasks

All Year 6 pupils tested nationally

Monday-Thursday week of 11th May 2020

Pupils receive raw score, which will be followed by a scaled score.

Gives government information about standards - doesn't affect places at secondary school.

English

Reading paper

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar paper

Writing assessed by teachers in June 2020.

Mathematics

1 Arithmetic paper (36 questions in 30 minutes)

2 40 minute 'reasoning' papers, both non-calculator

Science

No test but a teacher assessed level is submitted

Sampling may be done

2. What we do to help SATs week run smoothly

Plenty of preparation - in class, Boosters (Easter, English/Maths), technique tips, 1:1 or 2 tuition for some children, practice papers in class and at home, lots of talking, environmental issues (own classroom / smaller room)

familiar adults and peers etc), extra time applications etc.

Free SATs breakfast club (from 8 o'clock each day during the week)

Treats and fun every afternoon!

SATs scream after last test!

Test (Reading, Maths & SPAG):

- Your child's scaled score in is 107.
(A score of 100 or more means that your child has **met the expected standard**). NB: High score measure to be confirmed.

Teacher Assessment:

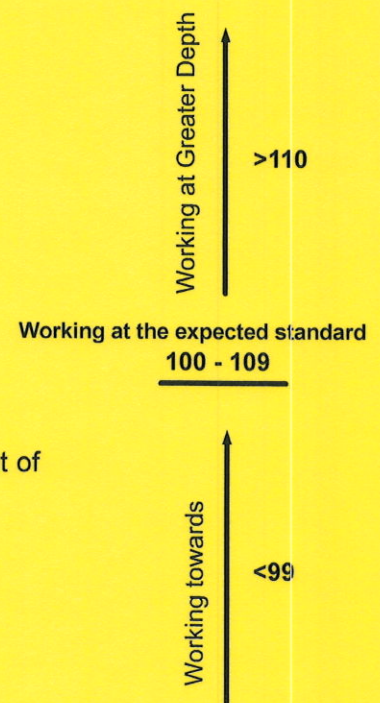
- Your child...

Need to be able to swim 25m in order to do lake activities (raft building and canoeing)

Medical issues and other relevant things (eg: night terrors) - confidential form nearer time

Contact with home - emergency only

No phones

No need to pack any food (including sweets)

Letters from home very welcome

Cost **£375 (or £225)** if your child is entitled to Free School Meals). Please pay by May half term.
