Christmas Trees from The Friends of Kentish Town

Payment will be via Parentpay. **Delivery of the trees will be to the school in the first week of December**, and collection will be from the school car park on the same day (exact day to be confirmed).

We are using the same company, Trees for Christmas, that we have used for many years and the trees are good and green. We even have parents coming back after their children have left Kentish Town C of E Primary just for our trees!

Watch out for the email, and place your order promptly. Trees vary in size from 3ft to 8ft, and are priced from around £25 - £55.
