## Temporary changes to children and young people's NHS services in north central London to continue over Christmas

If your child needs urgent healthcare this winter, be sure to go to the right place.

So that the NHS can continue to provide safe care to all residents during the pandemic, we have made some temporary changes to children and young people's services.

Emergency services for children and young people have temporarily closed at University College London Hospital and the Royal Free Hospital.

However, Barnet Hospital, the Whittington Hospital and North Middlesex Hospital children's emergency departments are still open.

These changes will continue throughout the Christmas period and over the winter, to help ease pressure on our hospitals.
