Dear Parents and Carers,

Swimming at Kentish Town Pool

From next Tuesday, our children have been offered sessions at Kentish Town Pool. I realise the session is different to the way your children would normally swim but I feel sure that like me, you are pleased that after so much lost swimming time in the last year, they are being offered an intensive block of sessions. Swimming is a vital life skill and I hope you will support us by providing your child/ren with kit as necessary. Thank you for your understanding.

Chloe will write to each class individually but the sessions will every day as follows:

Sycamore will start swimming on the 4th May and their last session is the 14th May.
Beech will start swimming on the 17th May and their last session is the 28th May.
Chestnut will start swimming on the 7th June and their last session is the 18th.

Cedar will swim in the autumn term and we hope to be able to offer swimming club for our younger children in the autumn as well.

Daily Supported Reading in Ash Class
