Terrorist Attack Last Friday

Class teachers will be speaking with their individual classes if the subject of the incident at London Bridge is raised by children. We have received some very good guidance from Camden and the PSHE Association on how to respond to questions from children.

We always carry out a site specific pre - trip visit for our school trips and staff always locate a “safe haven”, usually a local school, where children would be kept safe in the event of any sort of incident during a school trip. As you know, Hi Vis vests are worn so that children and staff can be spotted swiftly and mobile numbers are swapped by staff for quick communication.
