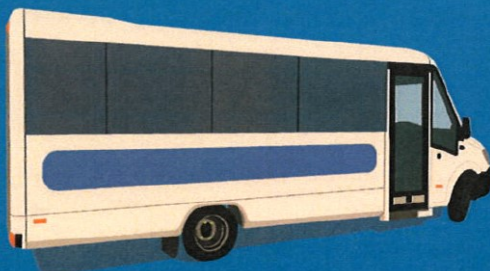
Camden Mobile Health

The **Camden Mobile Health** bus offers free NHS health checks, health information and advice to support residents to make positive health and wellbeing choices, and to prevent people aged 35 and over from developing serious health conditions in the future.



What to expect on board the bus



The NHS Health Check is 100% voluntary and takes about **20 to 30 minutes** to complete. The doctor or nurse working on the bus will record your age, height and weight, and your blood pressure. You may then be asked questions about your family history and lifestyle.

Once this is complete the healthcare professional will discuss your results with you, you may be given advice and suggested steps you can take to maintain or improve your health.
