Online Safety Coffee Morning



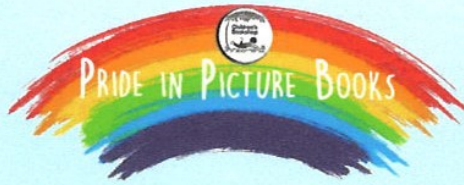
We will be holding a parent coffee morning on online safety on **Thursday the 30th June from 9-10 am.**

The focus will be on the current online risks to children but will also be an opportunity for all parents to ask any questions you may have regarding any aspect of online safety.

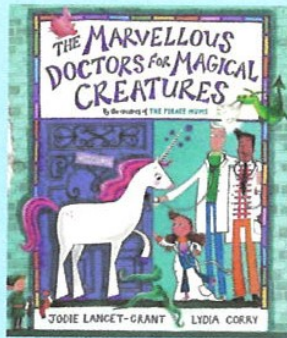
All parents are encouraged to attend and are welcome. The meeting will be in the staffroom.

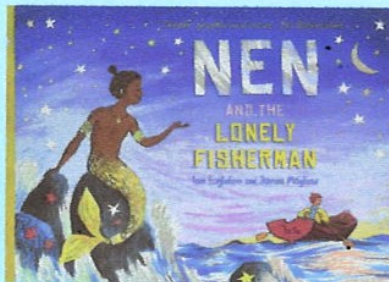

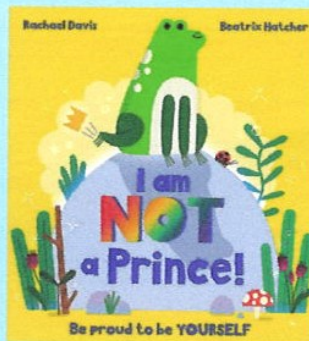
