Dear Parents and Carers,

This week it has been lovely to have Beech class back in school after their wonderful week at Foxlease in the New Forest. We have placed benches in shady spots in the playground and we will be limiting the children's exposure to the sun at lunchtime by offering children an indoor option with a film in class. Each morning, Jimmy opens the building and we let as much heat out as possible. There are no trips or visits on Monday or Tuesday next week.
