#### **Entrances to School**

From Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September parents/carers and children may enter the school through:

- 1. The Nursery/Early Years Foundation Stage gate;
- 2. The Main gate (outside the school office);
- 3. The Islip Street gate (outside Cedar class).

#### We will no longer be using the Frideswide Place gate that leads into the Safari Playground for entry or exit.

Parents and carers are very welcome on the school site and we ask that you hand your children over at the outside classroom door. All class rooms will be open at 8.50am <u>except</u> Acorns (nursery), which opens at 9.10am.

The school day ends at 3.15pm and parents/carers will need to collect from the outside classroom doors please. Children from Y4 upwards may walk home alone if you have given us your permission in writing that your child/ren may do this. Children who are attending Activity or other Clubs will be taken to the club by school staff.

#### **Breakfast and Activity Clubs**
