

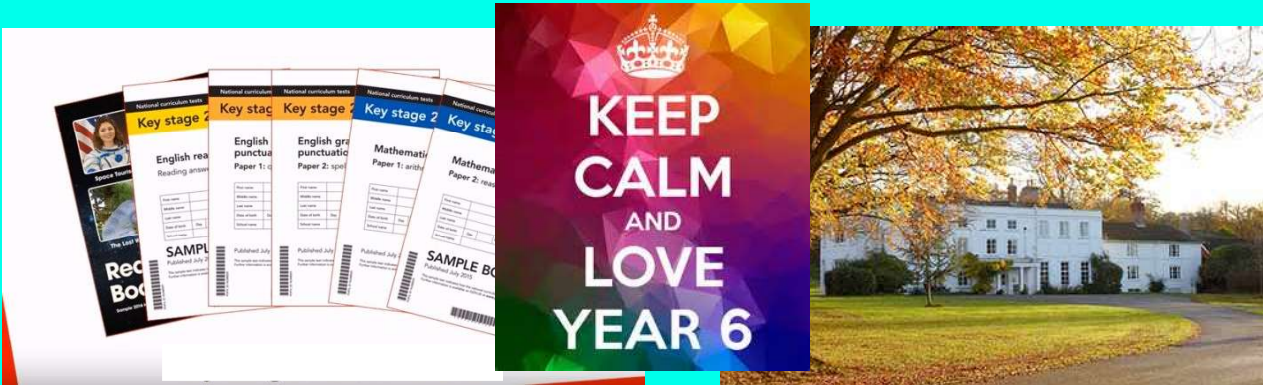

## What, when and why?

SATs = Statutory Assessment Tests

All Year 6 pupils tested nationally

Tuesday - Friday week of 8th May 2023

Children receive a level indicating whether they've achieved the expected outcome, below the expected outcome or above the expected outcome.

Gives government information about standards - doesn't affect places at secondary school.

### English

1 x Reading paper (1 hour)

1 x Spelling paper (20 spellings - no time limit)

1 x Punctuation and Grammar paper (45 minutes)

Writing assessed by teachers in June 2023.

### Mathematics

1 x Arithmetic paper (36 questions in 30 minutes)

2 x Reasoning papers (40 minutes each)

- no calculators in any Maths tests

### Science

No test but a teacher assessed level is submitted

Sampling may be done



# SATs

Tuesday 9th May to Friday 12th May 2023

- Tuesday 9 May: English grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) papers 1 (questions) and 2 (spelling)
- Wednesday 10 May: English reading paper
- Thursday 11 May: mathematics papers 1 (arithmetic) and 2 (reasoning)
- Friday 12 May: mathematics paper 3 (reasoning)

## Year 6 outcomes

The outcomes for these tests will be as follows:

### **SATs tests determine:**

Your child, in (Reading / SPaG / Maths), is working...

- Below Key Stage 2 level
- Below the expected Year 6 level (Working Towards)
- At the expected Year 6 level (Working at)
- Above the expected Year 6 level (Greater Depth)

### **Teacher assessment:**

Your child, in Writing, is working...

- Below Key Stage 2 level
- Below the expected Year 6 level (Working Towards)
- At the expected Year 6 level (Working at)
- Above the expected Year 6 level (Greater Depth)

## Foxlease - *What can the children expect?*

- A week long range of different outdoor activities with fully trained instructors.
  - Good quality fresh food
  - Spacious, comfy rooms to sleep in
- School adults the children know and trust



**Article 31: Children have the right to relax and play.**

## Foxlease 2023 - requirements

- Need to be able to swim 25m in order to do lake activities (raft building and canoeing)
- Medical issues and other relevant things (eg: night terrors) - confidential form to be sent home
  - Contact with home - emergency only
    - No phones
  - No need to pack any food (including sweets)
  - Letters from home very welcome
- Cost **£375** (or **£250** if your child is entitled to Free School Meals)\*. Please pay by May half term.

## Foxlease 2023 - timeline



**Article 31: Children have the right to relax and play.**

**End of February** - Permission slip goes home.

**Easter Holidays (Friday 31st March)** - Personal information form goes home  
(medical/allergies/dietary requirements)

**End of April** - Children say who they want to share rooms with (staff decide and allocate rooms)

**By Summer half term (Friday 26th May)** - Foxlease balance must be paid in full

- Kitlist goes home with full details about clothes, toiletries etc.

**Monday 19th June** - Leave for Foxlease!



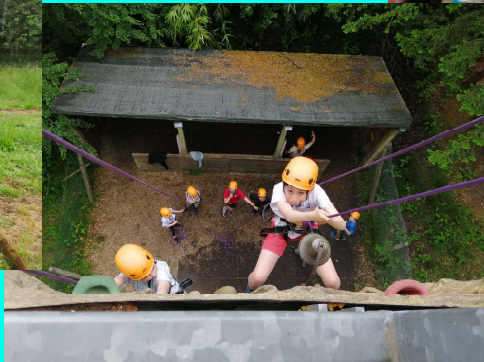
