Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had increasing numbers of parents coming into school very early in the afternoon to collect their children. If you do come in early, **please wait in the foyer until 3:20pm** before proceeding to the classroom door to collect your children.

Just a gentle reminder of the following timings for the beginning and end of the school day.

Start of the school day:

8:45am -Outside gates opened.

8:50am - Classroom doors opened.

9:00am -Registers opened and **outside gates closed.** (Please get a late card from the office if arriving after 9:00am)

9:10am -Registers closed.

End of the school day

Nursery gate opens at **3.15pm** for **3.20pm** collection

3:20pm - Outside gates opened

3:30pm - Classroom doors opened

3:40pm -Outside gates closed

Community Breakfast

8:15am on Wednesdays and Fridays.

All are welcome to attend for a delicious free breakfast. Please note that children **must** be accompanied by a parent or carer. Parents can then drop off their children at the classroom door at **8:50am**. Older siblings should also **not** be supervising younger siblings without a parent or carer present.

Before and After School Clubs.

Breakfast Club and other before school clubs start at 8:00am. Please do not send in children before this time.

After school clubs run from **3:30pm to 4:30pm** (apart from Activity Club). Please ring to club buzzer to alert the staff that you are ready to collect your child.

Please be patient if you are collecting your child early as on some days there are 4 different clubs running at the same time. It therefore does take time for a member of staff to locate your child and bring them to you.

Activity Club finishes at **5:30pm** promptly. Please ensure that your child is collected by **5:30pm**.
