Information on the structure and remit of the Governing Board and Committees.

Kentish Town CE Primary School is a Voluntary Aided school. It has 12 governors (1 Local Authority Governor, 1 Headteacher, 2 Parent Governors, 1 Staff Governor and 7 Co-opted Governors).

The Governing Body of Kentish Town CE Primary School was re-constituted in July 2014.

An 'interest' is where a member of the Governing Board may be affected personally or financially, directly or indirectly, or in some other way by a decision made at a meeting where the Governor is present. It includes business interests and personal relationships with member of staff, including spouses, partners and relatives.

Governors are required to declare any pecuniary interests held either personally or through a company or relative or partner.
