These are scheduled for the evenings of the 24th/25th November from 3:45pm. Further information about booking appointments will be released closer to the time.

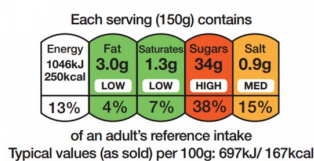
Years 3-6 Panto trip to the Hackney Empire

Did you children come home from school this week, talking about sugar and the amount of salt and fat in a lot of the foods we eat? We are working with all the children to get them to understand how unhealthy some of the foods we eat as snacks, are for you.
