## Hot Weather Arrangements and Safety Precautions

We would like to inform you that very hot weather is expected and we are taking additional steps to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all pupils while they are at school.

During periods of high temperatures, the school will put the following precautions in place:

- Pupils will be encouraged to drink water regularly throughout the day. **Please ensure your child brings a water bottle to school.**
- Outdoor activities, PE lessons, and break times will be adapted to reduce exposure to the heat.
- Pupils will have access to shaded areas when outside.
- Staff will monitor children closely for signs of overheating, tiredness, or discomfort.
- Classrooms will be kept as cool as possible by using ventilation/fans, closing blinds where appropriate, and adjusting activities if needed.
- Extra reminders will be given about sun safety, including wearing suitable clothing and applying sun protection before school.
- Postponing trips if necessary.
- Children will be encouraged to take part in quieter activities when temperatures are particularly high.

We kindly ask parents and carers to support us by:

- Sending children to school with a full bottle of water.
- Applying sunscreen before school where appropriate.
- Ensuring children wear lightweight, suitable clothing and bring a sun hat if required.
- Informing the school if your child has any health conditions that may be affected by hot weather.
- The safety and comfort of our pupils remain our priority, and we will continue to monitor conditions closely and make adjustments as needed.
