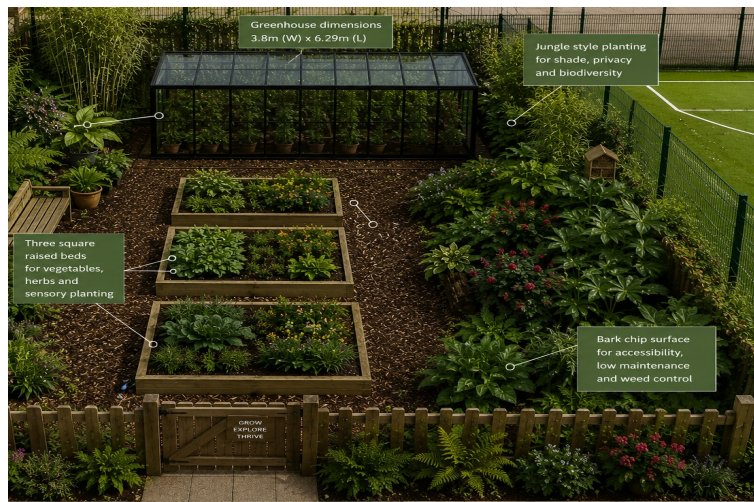
Beech Class Leavers' Service
